"Fall Path Through History Weekend" to Include History Tours of Lake George Battlefield Park, October 9-10

Lake George, NY – The Lake George Battlefield Park Alliance will be conducting guided tours of the Park's unique history as a key site in the French and Indian War and the American Revolution as part of New York State's "Fall Path Through History Weekend" on October 9-10.

The Alliance, formed in 2001 to help preserve the site and educate the public on its importance, is furnishing trained tour guides who will point out the ruins of Fort George (constructed in 1759), the burial place of four unknown soldiers who were killed in the Battle of Lake George (1755), the Park's historic statues and what they commemorate, and the remnants of hospitals and

kilns that served soldiers during the two 18th century conflicts, among other noteworthy spots within the Battlefield Park.
