## LG Battlefield Vistor Center, finally open

The long-anticipated Visitor Center at the Lake George Battlefield Park was to have its grand opening on Wednesday, May 25. It was created by the Lake George Battlefield Park Alliance and is located on Fort George Road in Lake George.

Operating hours are Fridays to Sundaysm 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. now through June. Hours will expand to five days a week from July 1 through Labor Day Weekend.

The Visitor Center will also be open on Memorial Day, May 30, "when many people are expected to attend the annual Remembrance Ceremony at the burial site in the Battlefield Park of Four Unknown Soldiers from the French and Indian War," the Alliance notes.

Admission is always free.

The Visitor Center was originally proposed in the 1890s, soon after New York State first acquired the property that was to become the Battlefield Park, the Alliance reminds us. It was "finally actualized" when the Lake George Park Commission and State Department of Environmental Conservation collaborated to construct a new headquarters and offered the first floor for displays.
