

# Lake George Battlefield Park Alliance conducting guided tours June 17, 18

The Lake George Battlefield Park Alliance will be conducting guided tours of the park's unique history as a key site in the French and Indian War and the American Revolution as part of New York State's "Path Through History Weekend" on June 17 at 11 a.m. and 18 at 1 p.m.

The tours start from the Lake George Battlefield Park Visitor Center at 75 Fort George Road.

The Alliance, formed in 2001 to help preserve the site and educate the public on its importance to American history, is providing trained tour guides who will point out the ruins of Fort George (constructed in

1759), the burial place of four unknown soldiers who were killed in the Battle of Lake George (1755), the park's historic statues and what they commemorate, and the remnants of hospitals and kilns that served soldiers during the two 18th century conflicts, among other noteworthy areas within the Battlefield Park.
