



Historian will lead free tour, LG Battlefield Park

The Lake George Battlefield Alliance said historian Mark Silo's "highly acclaimed" research to define the locations of British Army defensive lines during their tense engagement with attacking French and Native forces in 1755 will be the subject of a free "special tour" on Saturday, Oct. 12 at 1 p.m. from the Lake George Battlefield Park Visitor Center.

"Those taking the tour will view modern landscapes with a new lens as their circa 1755 contours and characteristics— along with their roles in the bitter battle on September 8— are identified," said the press release. "Each participant will receive a handout with illustrations to better understand the context of the Battle of Lake George."
